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# **Middle School Zoning Process & Timeline**

# Zoning Parameters:

- Board to charge the community committee to make a recommendation for Middle School Boundaries.
- Board to provide zoning parameters

## Recommended parameters for approval:

- Balance middle school enrollment/demographics
- Keep neighborhoods/subdivisions in tact
- Leverage natural boundaries as much as possible
- Efficiency in transportation systems
- Follow district policy on grandfathering options



# Zoning Process:

- Community Committee Process
- Committee size: 25 participants
- Establish a Committee member matrix:
  - 3 representatives from each elementary zone
    - 2 Representatives from larger subdivisions
    - 1 Representative from rural areas/smaller subdivisions
  - 2 Board member representatives
  - 2 Aspiring Leaders Academy members
- Participation by nomination & lottery selection
- Committee member roles are all at-large



# MS #3 Zoning Timeline:

- August 2019      Begin nomination process & selection
- September -      Committee meets: September 17, 24  
October 2019      October 1, 8, 15
- October 21      Presentation to the Board on  
Recommendation
- October 28-30      Community Information Sessions
- November 5 & 12      Committee meets to review input and  
make proposed changes
- November 18      Committee presents final recommendation
- December 16      Board Action
